## Items Include:

- 1 black jack table
- 1 card shoe
- 1 denim cover


## Instructions for playing:

King, Queen \& Jack count 10; Ace counts as 11 or 1, player chooses; all of the other cards are as marked.

Cards to total " 21 " or as close to " 21 " as possible, never going over or you are "BUSTED". An ace and a ten equals BLACKJACK - player wins $11 / 2$ times of his bet.

If the Player and the Dealer both get 21 it is a STANDOFF- Player does not win nor does he lose his bet.

The Dealer and all Players start with two cards each. The Dealer has one card face up and one face down. The Player's cards are dealt face down.
After the Player views his cards, he must decide whether to take additional cards or to "Stand" (taking no additional cards.) Any additional cards are dealt face up.
The Player may take as many cards as he wishes until he hits 21 or goes over 21.
If the Player goes over 21, he is BUSTED - he loses his bet.
The Dealer then plays. If he has a total of 16 or less, he must take a card until he reaches 17 or over. After reaching 17 or greater he cannot take additional cards.

WINNER: The one who hits " 21 " or comes closest to " 21 " while not going over.
